An orientation will be provided to you in the log area. Then your group will break into smaller groups with adult chaperones to explore the Farm on a self-guided tour.

Activities available:

- Brush, pet, or observe animals
- Feed dispensers are available for one quarter for a handful of feed for the animals.
- Dig for compost worms in the worm bin

- Rub herb leaves to smell their scent
- In the Learning Center:

  - Play the Life Box Game
  - Check out the other educational displays and posters
- Stroll through the vegetable gardens and orchard.
- Learn about weather in the Weather Station
- Plant seeds in a pot to take back to school. Let us know if you want to do this so we can set it up for you.
- Explore the greenhouse (Many of the plants are for sale)
- Learn about Native Americans in the Native American Cultural Area
- Enjoy the Pollinator Gardens with the many flowers, beneficial insects and hummingbirds.
- Count how many turtles you see in the pond.
