

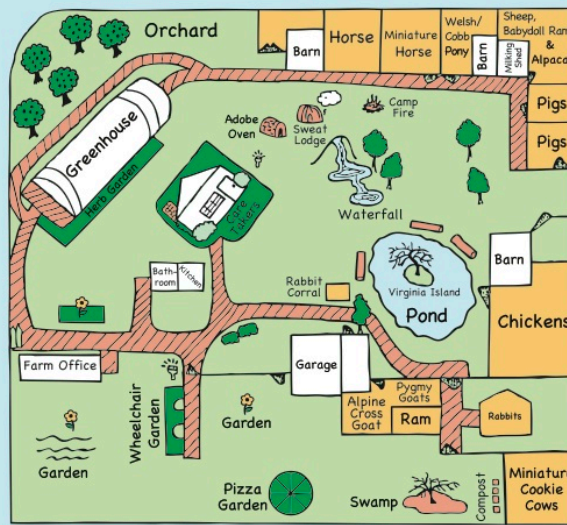
What is Loma Vista Farm?

Loma Vista Farm is a real working farm, garden, and outdoor classroom for students from all over the San Francisco Bay Area. Situated on five acres, the Farm is home to many animals including: horses, goats, sheep, chickens, rabbits, peacocks, ducks, geese, pigs, cows, cats, and an alpaca. The Farm, also, has an acre of organic gardens full of vegetables, fruit trees, and herbs, as well as a kitchen classroom, and a greenhouse. The Farm serves over 18,000 students of all ages and abilities per year, and provides an intriguing environment for education in science, art, math, reading, nutrition, human relations, and agricultural literacy.

Loma Vista Farm also provides educational opportunities through the local 4-H club as well as a "Summer Fun on the Farm" program serving elementary school kids. The Farm is open to the general public during operating hours and welcomes many adult-learners such as Master Gardeners, Carrington Community College Veterinary Technician students, and weekend workshops on gardening related topics for the community.

Our History

A pioneer in the school garden movement, Loma Vista Farm has been in operation since 1974 as a program of the Vallejo City Unified School District. The mission then, as it is today, is to provide hands on education in a farm-based setting. In 2003, the Friends of Loma Vista Farm non-profit organization was formed to partner with the school district to assist with educational quality and financial sustainability.

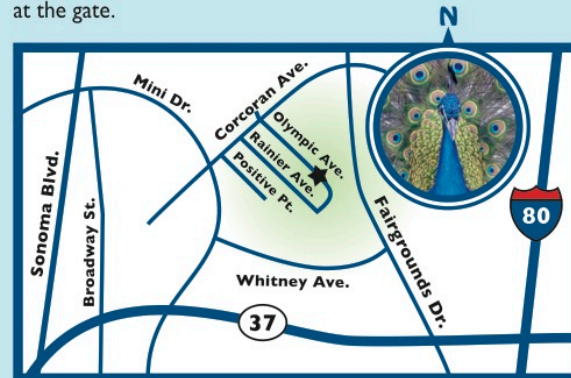
