



Farm Noun Walk

Before going on Farm noun walk, give students a definition of a NOUN.

NOUN: The name of a person (animal), place, or thing.

Have students walk around the Farm in partners or in small groups looking for Farm nouns. Have them record their nouns on the attached chart.

Here are some Farm nouns to help you get started:

ANIMALS (PEOPLE)	PLACES	THINGS
farmers Rita Rebecca sheep goats chickens worms guineafowl	swamp greenhouse lathhouse kitchen pond barn toolshed adobe oven	shovel cart trowel onion rock apple tree dirt compost

Come back to class with the noun chart. You may want to make a class noun chart compiling all of the nouns collected by each team OR you may want students to make noun books.

Be sure to illustrate the chart and books.

Noun charts can be used as vocabulary for writing or for spelling words.
