### Directions:

1. Choose an animal, plant, or object on the Farm that you are interested in.
2. Choose a place to sit, stand, or lie down where you can observe the animal, plant, or object.
3. Carefully observe the animal, plant, or object. Use all your senses! Try to observe every part of it as well as the whole thing.
4. Use the bottom and the back of this paper and write poems in any style you want about your observations. Think about these questions:
  - **What sounds, feelings, sights, smells, or tastes do you notice?**
  - **What movements do you notice?**
  - **What would you compare them all to?**
  - **Think of some similes or metaphors that compare what you chose to something else.**
  - **Describe shapes, colors, movements in detail using adjectives with your nouns and adverbs with your verbs.**
  - **Try using personification. Imagine what your animal, plant, or object might be thinking or feeling. What would it say if it could talk?**
